When Did I See You?

Matthew 24:34-40

³⁴ "Then the King will say to those on His right, 'Come, you blessed of My Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world.

³⁵ For I was hungry, and you gave Me something to eat; I was thirsty, and you gave Me something to drink; I was a stranger, and you invited Me in;

³⁶ I was naked, and you clothed Me; I was sick, and you visited Me; I was in prison, and you came to Me

³⁷ Then the righteous will answer Him, 'Lord, when did we see You hungry, and feed You, or thirsty, and give You something to drink?

³⁸ And when did we see You as a stranger, and invite You in, or naked, and clothe You?

³⁹ And when did we see You sick, or in prison, and come to You?'

⁴⁰ The King will answer and say to them, 'I assure you and most solemnly say to you, to the extent that you did it for one of these brothers of Mine, even the least of them, **You did it for Me.**'



³³ And He will cause the sheep to stand at His right hand, but the goats at His left.


Further Study
